The school has implemented several new initiatives providing diagnostic formative assessments to identify specific student needs, inform placement decisions, and direct teaching and learning. Applications of technology are playing an increasingly important role in instruction, exemplified by the newly implemented Blackboard Learning System, and an increasing number of projection systems installed. The HAWK (Honor, Achievement, Work ethic, Knowledge) Academy was created to support improved academic performance and encourage positive student behaviors.
